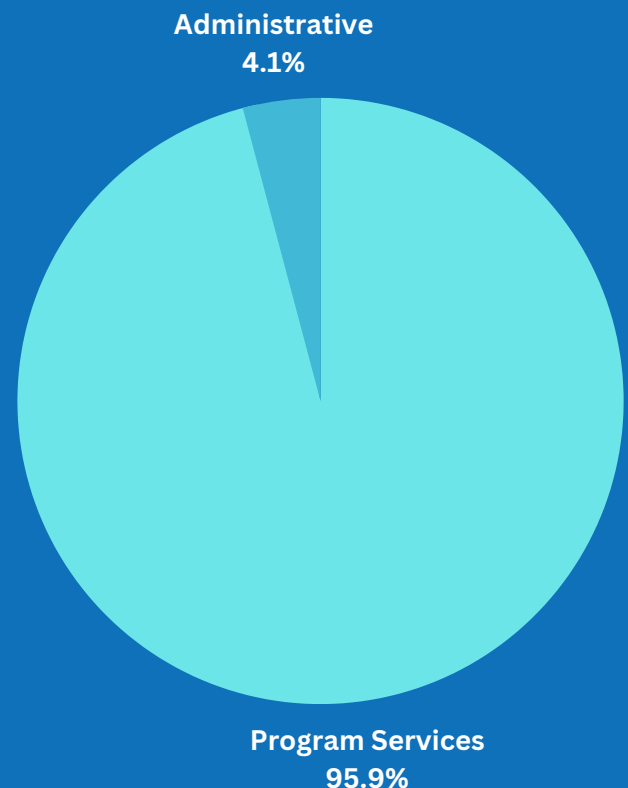
## 2022 Revenue
